### THOUGHTS FROM FATHER HARRIS

From the pastor...

[One day Jesus healed a blind person. When some Pharisees closed their eyes to the healing and its meaning, Jesus said to them,] "I came ...so that the blind should see and those who see should become blind." John 9:39

Astronaut Ed Aldrin was involved in the first moon landing. He said that he hoped its technical success would not blind us to its deeper meaning. His point was this: Seen from the moon, our earth appears as a tiny spaceship. That perspective of earth, says Aldrin, highlights — for those with eyes to see — that we are one family under God and should start living that way.

What tends to keep me from seeing that we are all one family under God? How might I keep myself from being "blinded" by this difficulty?


#### A Biblical Walk Through the Mass
