THOUGHTS FROM FATHER HARRIS

This weekend's bulletin covers two weekends: May 28 for the Feast of Ascension and June 4 the Feast of Pentecost

The Feast of Ascension is where Jesus returns to heaven. Jesus's work was now complete. On the Feast of Pentecost the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples and gave them the power to speak boldly about the gospel, heal people in Jesus' name and witness to the power of God. So what does that look like? A woman saw a little girl in the street playing with filthy trash. The child poorly dressed and ill-nourished. The woman became angry and said to God, "Why do you let a thing like that happen in the world you created? Why don't you do something about it?" God replied, "I did something about it; I created you." That story invites me to ask myself; "How seriously do I take Jesus' command to transform our world into the kind of place God created it to be?" MSION BY MAIK Link) Jesus calls us to witness in anyway possible that is the story of the Ascension. On Pentecost the Holy Spirit changed the disciples' lives. The Cross and the Switchblade describes Rev. David Wilkerson's work with young derelicts in the New York City. One firsthand report from the book comes from a heroin user named Joe. He says; "The Holy Spirit is called the comforter, they told me. When I thought of comfort, I thought of a bottle of wine and a dozen goof balls. But these guys were talking about comfort from heaven where I could feel clean later. I got to wanting this.... I cried to God for help and that's when he [the Holy Spirit] came... I didn't want any more drugs. I loved everybody. For the first time in my life I felt clean." (VISION by Mark Link)

FROM THE PARISH ADMINISTRATOR

St. Bridget Catholic Cemetery Guidelines

To better serve all families who have entrusted their beloved to our care, the parish pastoral council of St. Bridget Catholic Church has established the following guidelines:

- Decorating the grave with natural flowers is welcomed and preferred. All flowers must be placed in elevated urns in line with the headstones or attached to the monument. Glass/breakable containers are not acceptable.
- Any planting of flowers, plants, shrubs or trees on or near the grave site is not allowed.
- The concrete mowing edge around the base of monument remain must clear decorations/objects at all times.
- Free-standing chairs/benches and similar items are not permitted.
- Shepherd hooks must be securely placed in line with the headstone.
- Solar lights must be placed in line with the headstone in an elevated urn and not placed directly in the grass.
- Flowers placed at the time of an interment will be left a minimum of five days. Potted plants left from funerals will be discarded.
- All plants, flowers and decorations that are not maintained, detract from the appearance of the cemetery, or are deemed distasteful or unsafe will be removed cemeterv by management.
- All decorations (including flowers, wreaths, stands, holders, etc.) are the responsibility of the family. Any fall/winter items remaining on March 15 will be removed and discarded for spring clean-up.
- St. Bridget Cemetery is not liable for any items which are lost, stolen, or damaged.

St. Bridget Cemetery Plots

As the cost of maintaining our parish cemetery has increased (regular maintenance as well as overall improvements) and the number of cremations has reduced the number of purchased plots, the parish pastoral council has voted to change the price of a plot at St. Bridget Cemetery to \$800. This price increase will take effect July 1, 2017.
