- Courses are subject to cancellation if we do not have the minimum number of students registered.

- Regular attendance is expected for all summer school classes.
- Students should arrive no more than 10 minutes before their class begins as there is limited supervision available.
- The office must be notified at least two weeks before the start of the class if it is necessary to drop a class. Refunds will be given if the minimum number of students is not affected.

## 2017 Course Descriptions

**Exploring the World of Author/Illustrator Eric Carle** (June 12-15 for Grades 2-5 with Mrs. Gribble & Mrs. Perrizo-Peterson) - In this fun-filled class, students will read amazing literature while exploring their creative side. Art in the class will be inspired by the techniques of Eric Carle. Some activities will include paste paper collage, painting, cooking, and story writing.

**Animal Masks** (June 12-15 for Grades 2-5 with Mrs. Gribble & Mrs. Perrizo-Peterson) - Come join the fun as we create paper mache masks based on a special animal of your choice. This is a great opportunity to explore 3D art and work with a great array of fun materials.

**STEAM challenges** (July 10-13 for Grades K-2 with Ms. Hawkins) – Come prepared to get creative and build fun and challenging activities! Kids will be working with a variety of materials to build, create and challenge their brains. Please send your child with a bag of recyclable items for a few projects.

**Mad Science** (July 10-13 for Grades K-2 with Ms. Hawkins)— Kids will have a blast building and creating messy science projects! Please bring a white t-shirt for your lab coat (please send a shirt that can get messy, this will be tie dyed on the last day.)

It’s sure to be a fun-filled evening.

**Finding Dory Night** (Parents’ Night Out July 27<sup>th</sup> 6-8pm) – Join Mrs. Bodin & Ms. Hawkins for night of movie magic! Play fun games, make a craft, and eat a snack with your friends!
