WHAT IS LIVING OUR FAITH?

We are called to Live Our Faith (LOF) in this world. These evenings are designed to find new ways or rediscover ways we may have forgotten to be Catholic in the modern world.

Growing in faith is not only for children. Living Our Faith will offer three different areas of focus each evening:

Life Experience:

Studies on topics such as parenting, worship, grief and marriage

Scripture/Spiritual:

An introduction to the Bible; a two-night study on the women of the Bible; the sacraments and a video study of religions of the world will be offered

Prayer:

Join with others in the Chapel for an hour of prayer in support of all of the people in faith formation, for the intentions of the parish and for the needs of the world. Prayer has Power.

WHAT DOES LIVING OUR FAITH MEAN

LOF provides an opportunity to continue to nourish our faith in fellowship with our community. The Catechism tells us that "To live, grow, and persevere in the faith until the end we must nourish it with the word of God" (CCC 162).

Highlights of Some of the Programs:

NOOMA – a series of short films providing spiritual perspectives on individual life experiences. A period of discussion will follow each video.

Great Religions of the World – One-hour videos on Protestantism, Judaism, Islam, Catholicism and Hinduism narrated by Ben Kingsley.

A&E Biography of Michelangelo Buonarrotti, Master of the Sistine Chapel ceiling.

Fr. Solanus Casey, born on a farm near Oak Grove, WI on a journey to sainthood.

Word by Word – A program created by LifeTeen to introduce the new Roman Missal to adults.

Finding Christ in Your Marriage: Using scripture passages, this book study explores ways to find Christ in your every day life, marriage and parenting.

Our prayer for you is that God speaks to you in a way that moves you to deeper faith, hope and love.
