Fasting and Abstinence Regulations

Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and on Good Friday.

Everyone between 18 and 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Besides the abstention from meat, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday only one full meal is allowed. If truly needed to maintain necessary strength, up to two very small meals may be also be taken, but together these additional meals should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.


