From the pastor...

This bulletin covers the weekends of June 20, the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time and June 27, the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary time.


The Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary time is the gospel story of a woman suffering from a 12 year long ailment and said to herself, "If I just touch his (Jesus) clothes, I will get well." She touched his cloak, and was healed," Mark 5:28-29

Sandra Hook, a Canadian teacher, was doing volunteer summer work for Mother Teresa in the slums of India. One day she was asked to bathe a woman covered with sores. She shuddered at the thought. Then she recalled what Mother Teresa had said, "When you touch the poor, touch them as though you are touching the loving Jesus." At that moment Sandra saw the woman through the eyes of faith and had no difficulty bathing her. It is this kind of childlike faith, also, that healed the woman in today's gospel. May we do likewise. The Thirteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time we hear that [Jesus went to his home in Nazareth, only to be rejected by many people.]

The summer Olympics are happening this year. The Olympics date back to 776 B.C. Many towns honored victors by erecting a statue in their honor. A Greek story concerns a town that honored such a hero. The hero's rival was so envious that one night he rocked the statue back and forth and toppled it. It fell and crushed him.... The cancer of envy is often a factor in why prophets are not respected in their hometowns. To what extent is envy a factor in my life and work?
