Middle School Seder Meal to celebrate

A Christian Seder meal is a modified version of the Jewish Passover Seder, or ritual meal, for use in families. It is most effective in teaching children and parents the tradition of the Mass, a representation of the Last Supper of our Lord with his apostles, where He instituted the sacrifice of the Mass and the priesthood. The Seder menu consists of a few basic foods, including four cups of wine, matzah, and bitter herbs. The focal point of Passover is a communal meal, called the Seder, which is a time of rejoicing and celebration at the deliverance for the Hebrews that God accomplished in the exodus.
