About Leech Lake

Your group will meet a host of different community friends with unique backgrounds and rich stories about the Leech Lake area. You'll serve by assisting with home-improvement projects, children's programs, and through projects at the Bug-O-Nay-Ge-Shig School, a school that intentionally teaches the Ojibwe language and culture. In the evenings, you'll have the opportunity to visit Norway Beach in the Chippewa National Forest, learn about Native American culture and spirituality from an Ojibwa perspective, participate in a scavenger hunt around Bemidji and experience a community cookout that sometimes includes drummers and dancers. YouthWorks has partnered with this community since 2000.

We (YouthWorks) seek to listen to local ministry partners as we return to the same communities year after year. It is our desire to walk side-by-side with our friends in service, helping support the work God is already doing through them. We realize every community we enter has both struggles and strengths, and we have much to learn from them.
