From Fr. Joe's Desk:

Holy Communion and intinction. Some people asked if they could dip the host in the Precious Blood and receive in this manner. The simplest answer is No. This is called intinction and it is reserved only for priests or deacons. The people in the congregation "cannot" intinc the host into the precious blood at all.



The Month of March: There are two very popular Saints' feast days this month and they are only two days apart. One is designated as a "Feast Day" and the other is designated as a "Solemnity." Every Saint is ranked. Those Saints that are listed as a Memorial Saint can either be recorded as an "Obligatory Memorial" or an "Optional Memorial". "Obligatory Memorial" simply means that they must be celebrated (unless it falls on a Sunday). If any Solemnity, Feast day, or Memorial falls on a Sunday, it is not celebrated during the Mass, because Sunday is reserved for the resurrection of Jesus. If it is a Solemnity, and it falls on a Sunday, it is usually moved to Monday. If the saint is designated as an "Optional Memorial" they don't have to be cele-

moved to Monday. If the saint is designated as an "Optional Memorial," they don't have to be celebrated at all. Which two saints are this month? The Feast Day of St. Patrick-March 17 and the Solemnity of St. Joseph (husband of Mary and earthly father of Jesus). St. Patrick is the Patron Saint of Ireland. He is a very popular saint in places like Chicago that fill their river with green dye, or New York City and their St. Patrick's Day parade. St. Joseph is the Patron Saint of the Universal Church, fathers, adopted fathers, carpenters, craftsmen, and laborers. He is mentioned in the Eucharistic prayers for the celebration of the Holy Mass since Vatican II (1962-1965). He has many titles. 


