We continue to celebrate the Easter Season. What a joyous time in our Church Year. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for the well wishes...it was a little bit of a rough start to Holy Week for me. But prayer and this parish community pulled us through. Thank you to all who helped in any way to make this week so wonderful. Our lituraical celebrations were truly a coming together of the Body of Christ.



The Easter Octave Gospels are such a powerful testimony to the mission of discipleship. Each of the Gospels of the Octave week present an invitation to each of us to be "feet on the ground" and be witnesses to all that God has done in our lives. Each Gospel (Matthew 28:8 - 15, John 20:11 - 18, Luke 24:13 - 35, Luke 24:35 - 48, and John 21:1 - 14) guides us to ways in which we can become Jesus' disciples. It is through awareness, action, recognition, faith, trust and gratitude, that we are equipped and able to be workers for Christ in the kingdom.

In the last bulletin we presented one of the questions we are discussing as we face some of the situations facing the Church, not just here at St. Bridget, throughout the diocese of Superior. The first question we are asked to consider is the mass schedule and what would be ideal to meet the mission of evangelization, the care of our aging priests, and limited pool of volunteers, so as to assure the continuation of vibrant liturgical celebrations. One of the possibilities would be to shift to one mass time on Sunday. Because we know that this affects all of us, we want to hear from you. We want to invite you to attend a listening session where we can hear your thoughts. The first session will take place on Sunday, April 21 at 1:00 p.m. and the second session will take place Sunday, April 28 at 4:00 p.m. At these sessions criteria and information that has been gathered will be presented and you will be given an opportunity to share your comments.

Please keep in mind that this is not just a process we are doing here at St. Bridget/St. Mary and Newman, but it is a process that all churches within our diocese are prayerfully discerning.

May our Lord guide us as He did the first disciples and may we be strengthened in our faith through this time of discernment and change.


