Practice Dying



While on his deathbed, Plato, the great philosopher (429-347), was asked by a friend to sum up his whole life's work. After much reflection, he replied two words, "Practice dying". Plato was saying: why wait until you are dying, be transformed now! This is something we can practice dying from moment to moment. Dying to the past, dying to the known, dying to the false, surrendering to the unknown, trusting what it is, and trusting God.

Stephen Levine once said, "If you had a year to live, what would you do, whom would you call, what would you say and why are you waiting?"

It could be a year, a month, a week, a day and an hour. Nothing is certain except the fact that each and every one of us will die. Knowing this (without fearing it) can inspire us, take us deeper into the present moment, help us to live more fully and passionately, encourage us to give everything of ourselves, to love, laugh, share and become closer to one another. Plato's final instruction to his disciples, just before death, is an admonition we should all take to heart. It affects not only our behavior at the time of death and how we deal with that, but our preparation prior to the time of death - that is, how we live our life.

This is all of a piece, for the moment of death and its quality depends on what has gone before and where our consciousness is placed. We need a philosophy of life that ultimately become a practice for the act and art of dying and our transition in the ongoing continuation of consciousness.
