"Where there is love there is no burden. Of there is burden, the burden itself is loved".



Social Justice

The River Falls Food Pantry is in need of crackers, cereal, body soap, and spices. The parish contributed 108 items to the Food Pantry in December, bringing the year's total contributions to 1894 items -- a sum that made life for our neighbors and friends easier and less stressful. That total exceeds that of 2024: **1054 food items.**

One of the areas we can effect change in the new year is the environment and how we respond to it. There are simple things that we can do in our daily lives to help the environment. These things revolve around our use of plastics and single use items. Use storage containers instead of Ziplock bags. Consider a Bento lunch box with reusable containers for sandwiches, fruits, and snacks. Instead of buying plastic bags for your small waste baskets, line the baskets with the plastic bags your groceries come home in. Better yet, take reusable and washable tote bags to the grocery store with you. If everyone does just a little bit every day, together we can make a big impact.
