From the pastor...

The school year is off and running. It is good to see students back in school and the activities of fall begin. Another season comes upon us.

This Sunday the St. Thomas More Chapel Sunday night Masses resume at 7:00 p.m. on the UWRF campus. All are welcome to attend these Masses. A reminder we have a Spanish Mass once a month at 2:00 p.m. on the second Sunday of each month at St. Mary's Immaculate Conception Church in Hammond. If you can help with music or like to get involved, please contact me.

This Sunday is the 23rd week in Ordinary Time. Part of the scripture is Mark 7:33-35 "Jesus took [the deaf-mute] off alone, away from the crowd, put his fingers in the man's ears, spat, and touched the man's tongue. Then Jesus [prayed] ... At once the man was able to hear... and he began to talk."

Many hearing-impaired people awake each day not to the sound of an alarm on a table, but to the whir of a clock that vibrates under their pillow. Like the deaf-mute in the gospel, these people live in a silent world. For them, turning on the radio is useless. Watching TV is a bland experience. But the plight of a physical deaf-mute is nothing compared to the plight of a spiritual deaf-mute - someone who can't hear God or talk to God in prayer. And all of us fall into this category at least a few times in our lives. Spiritually, we live in a silent world.

Have I ever asked Jesus to take me off "away from the crowd" and heal me of my spiritual deafness and dumbness?
